

CMPAC's Policy Updates

January 9 - 20, 2025

Dear CMPAC Community,

The <u>announcement</u> of a ceasefire in Gaza after 15 months of relentless violence offers a moment of much-needed relief for Palestinians who have endured unimaginable suffering. While we acknowledge the significance of this temporary halt in fighting, CMPAC emphasizes that a ceasefire alone is not enough to address the root causes of the ongoing oppression. The devastation, including the unreported toll on civilian lives, and the continued occupation demand immediate and sustained action. The international community must work toward justice, ensuring that the atrocities of the past months are not forgotten, and that accountability is pursued.

As we reflect on the ceasefire's <u>implications</u>, CMPAC remains committed to advocating for the rights, dignity, and freedom of Palestinians. The work is far from over, and we must continue pushing for long-term solutions - ending the occupation, rebuilding Gaza, and holding those responsible for war crimes accountable.

CMPAC Calls for Strong Action Against UNRWA Ban




January 9 - With Israel's decision to ban the United Nations Relief and Works Agency (UNRWA) in Palestine, Canada must take decisive action. While Canada has condemned this move, words are no longer enough. CMPAC urges Canada to push back against this violation of international law and be prepared to impose political and economic sanctions.

CMPAC Highlights Underreported Gaza Death Toll

January 10 - A study published by *The Lancet* reveals that the Gaza death toll has been underreported by approximately 41%, bringing the actual number closer to 78,000. CMPAC demands that Canada cease its complicity in the #GazaGenocide and calls for an immediate bilateral arms embargo.



CMPAC Calls for Accountability for Denied Humanitarian Aid

January 13 - The UN attempted to reach North Gaza 165 times between October 6 and December 31, 2024, but 149 of these missions were blocked. CMPAC calls on Canada to denounce these violations and prepare to impose sanctions against Israel for obstructing humanitarian aid.
