CMPAC Comments on Amnesty's Report: Israel's Actions Constitute Genocide

by Amnesty International has concluded that Israel is committing genocide against Palestinians, based on an extensive review of actions and statements from October 7, 2023. The report urges those with influence over Israel to take immediate action to end the violence. CMPAC calls on Canada to impose a bilateral arms embargo with Israel, enforce sanctions, and fully cooperate with the International Criminal Court in executing arrest warrants for Netanyahu and Gallant.

December 3 - CMPAC fully supports our Jewish allies in their calls for justice for the Palestinian people in Ottawa. Recent peaceful pro-Palestinian protests have been met with disproportionate and biased violent responses by the Ottawa Police. We demand accountability and urge the Ottawa Police to uphold protesters' fundamental rights to freedom of expression and assembly.

Canada Must Act Now

CMPAC Demands Strong Action Against Genocide in Gaza

December 3 - The UN has condemned Gaza's situation as reaching apocalyptic levels, with nearly 19,000 children hospitalized due to malnutrition in the past 4 months. CMPAC calls for Canada to:

- Cooperate fully with the International Criminal Court (ICC).
- Apprehend and surrender Netanyahu and Gallant to the ICC.
- 3. Support the ICC's investigative work on war crimes.

Canada must act now to ensure accountability for the use of starvation as a genocide tactic.

CMPAC Calls Out Canada's Refugee Double Standard

CMPAC Urges Action on the International Day of Solidarity with Palestinians

November 29 - On the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People, CMPAC reaffirms its commitment to Palestinian self-determination and condemns the growing vilification of Palestinian advocacy in Canada. CMPAC calls for concrete action on the following:

- 1. Uphold the ICC's arrest warrants for Netanyahu and Gallant.
- 2. Confront anti-Palestinian racism in Canada, ensuring freedom of speech.
- 3. Suspend military aid and impose a two-way arms embargo on Israel.

Canada must align its foreign policy with its commitment to human rights.

CMPAC Supports ICC Arrest Warrants for Netanyahu and Gallant

November 27 - CMPAC strongly supports the UN's call for countries to comply with the ICC arrest warrants for Netanyahu and Gallant. Canada must execute these warrants and suspend military aid and trade agreements with Israel to align its foreign policy with its stated commitment to human rights.

CMPAC Condemns Killings of Humanitarian Workers in Gaza

November 27 - CMPAC condemns the unprecedented killing of humanitarian aid workers in Gaza, exacerbated by Israeli bombings. We call for an immediate bilateral arms embargo to end Canada's complicity in the deaths of these workers. This cannot be Canada's legacy.
