


Important Updates: Canada's Political Scene, Israeli Ceasefire Violations, and VotePalestine.ca Platform

CMPAC's Open Letter to Prime Minister Carney Outlining Muslim Community's Expectations



CMPAC is calling on Prime Minister Mark Carney to take immediate action on key issues affecting Canada's Muslim community. We demand an end to Canada's complicity in the Gaza genocide, protection of civil liberties, and urgent reforms to address systemic Islamophobia and anti-Palestinian racism.

Our demands include:

- (1) End Canada's complicity in Gaza and impose a two-way arms embargo on Israel.
- (2) Condemn the use of starvation as a weapon and support humanitarian aid for Gaza.
- (3) Defend civil liberties and freedom of expression, especially regarding pro-Palestine advocacy.
- (4) Reform the Gaza Reunification TRV Program for Palestinian families.
- (5) Address systemic Islamophobia and anti-Palestinian racism within Canadian institutions.

CMPAC Issues Statement on Israel's Ceasefire Violations in Gaza



CMPAC issued a statement today calling on Canada to address Israel's ceasefire violations in Gaza. In the weeks following the January 2025 ceasefire agreement, Israel has committed at least 962 violations. CMPAC calls for the following immediate steps:

- 1. Utilize diplomatic channels to enforce the ceasefire and advance peace negotiations.
- 2. Condemn the use of starvation as a weapon and demand unrestricted humanitarian access.
- 3. Hold Israel accountable for ceasefire violations.
- 4. Fulfill its moral and humanitarian obligations to Gaza.

CMPAC welcomes Mark Carney's election as leader of the Liberal Party of Canada on March 9, 2025. As he begins his term, CMPAC calls on him to demonstrate principled leadership by renewing Canada's commitment to international law and supporting the International Court of Justice's (ICJ) measures. Canadians expect real action on justice and accountability. Carney should commit to the following:

- 1. Demand an end to Israel's blockade, use of starvation as a weapon, and occupation of Gaza and contribute to ending the humanitarian crisis in Gaza
- 2. Impose a two-way arms embargo on Israel
- 3. Recognize Palestinian statehood
- 4. Hold Israel and Israeli officials accountable for war crimes
- 5. Defend freedom of expression and combat Anti-Palestinian Racism in all its forms
