CMPAC is proud to announce the launch of <u>MuslimsVote.ca</u>, our federal election campaign to build political power grounded in justice and collective Muslim values. In a time of rising injustice, we are organizing around a clear message: we will vote on principle, and we will put Palestine on the ballot.

### CMPAC's First Endorsed Candidates – 2025 Federal Election

### **CMPAC Open Letter to Party Leaders**



On April 2, CMPAC issued an <u>open letter to all federal party leaders</u>, urging them to take a clear stance on the ongoing atrocities in Gaza. The letter condemns Israel's actions as war crimes and crimes against humanity, highlighting the devastating impact on Palestinian civilians, particularly women and children. CMPAC calls on political leaders to publicly condemn these violations and reaffirm Canada's commitment to justice and accountability. The letter also stresses the importance of protecting civil liberties, freedom of expression, and protest rights, noting that the government's stance on Palestine affects these freedoms at home, particularly for Muslim, Arab, and pro-justice communities. CMPAC emphasizes that a party's position on Palestine will be a decisive factor for many voters in the upcoming election.

CMPAC has partnered with four other national Muslim organizations - Arab-Canadian Vote, Canadian Muslim Healthcare Network, HIKMA, and the National Muslim Action Fund - to form a principled endorsement taskforce for the 2025 federal election. This collaboration has resulted in the release of a joint slate of unanimously endorsed candidates, selected based on their alignment with Muslim community values, support for justice for Palestine, and a commitment to a more equitable Canada. The endorsement process is consensus-based and ongoing.
