Following the Canadian federal leaders' debate, CMPAC has published a commentary highlighting a disturbing truth: the ongoing genocide in Gaza was largely ignored. In a moment demanding moral clarity, party leaders offered silence, deflection, or vague platitudes - failing to meet the urgency of this humanitarian crisis. This reflects a political culture increasingly detached from principles of justice, human rights, and international law.

As Muslim and Palestinian communities across Canada watch closely, we will continue to challenge double standards, racialized narratives, and the systemic neglect of Palestinian lives. We remain committed to advocating for principled foreign policy and real protections against anti-Palestinian racism and Islamophobia here at home.

#### **New TRV Toolkit Launch!**


